# MASH By-Laws Change to Allow Online Voting – Public Comment

I propose that section 3.3.2 of the MASH By-Laws, which presently read as the following:

3.3.2 Directors shall be elected or re-elected by the voting members at the Annual Meeting, and will be elected by a simple majority of members present at the Annual Meeting.

be amended to read as the following:

3.3.2 Directors shall be elected or re-elected by the voting members of MASH, and will be elected by a simple majority of members. Voting may take place either in person at the Annual Meeting, or may be conducted using online voting tools in advance of the Annual Meeting. The method for members to vote should be made public at least two (2) months prior to the election. If the vote is to be conducted using online tools, sufficient effort should be made to ensure the vote is restricted to voting members of MASH, that it is made secure, and that it is conducted fairly. Results of the election shall be made public at the Annual Meeting.
