- 3) **Secretary** — Record keeper, taking and/or posting meeting minutes, custodian of Club records and oversees the maintenance of the Club website, Calendar and social media accounts.
- 4) **Treasurer** — Responsible for the care, custody and reporting of all Club funds. Pays all the bills, handles reimbursements.
- 5) **Librarian** — Holds and maintains the Club's library of brewing books and periodicals, keeps up-to-date records of Club membership for each calendar year.

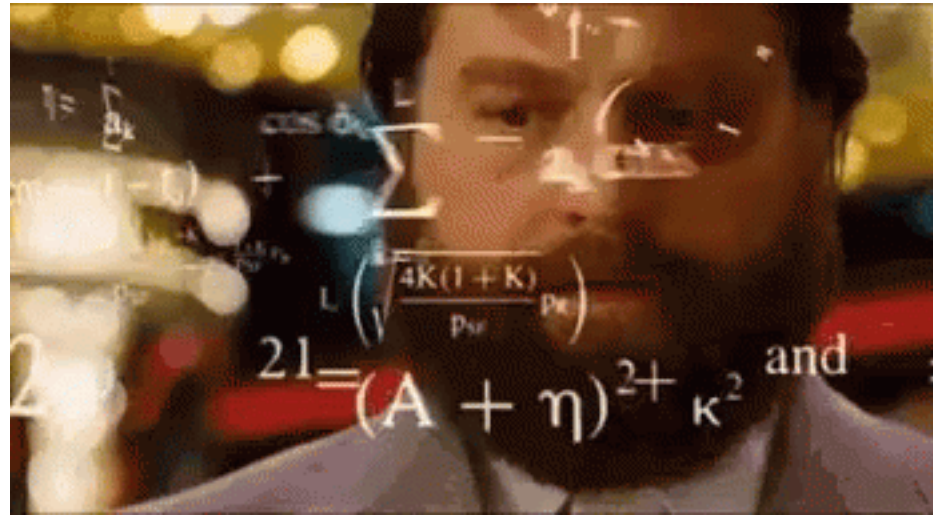
