Event Overview

Big Brew Day is an annual celebration of **National Homebrew Day**, organized by the American Homebrew Association. In 2026, it will be held on **Saturday, May 2**. Homebrewers from around the world gather to brew together, share tips, and celebrate the craft of homebrewing, whether they are beginners or experienced brewers. [↪ Homebrewers Association](#)

Recipes and Brewing

The official 2026 beer recipes include three **National Homebrew Competition gold medal winners**:

- **George and Aaron's Pre-Prohibition Porter**
- **Monk's Ration Trappist-Style Single**
- **Dark Cellar Imperial Stout**

Participants can choose to brew one or all three recipes. For alternative options, the AHA's **Homebrew**





Big Brew Day Competition 2026



The American Homebrewers Association annual Big Brew Day is Saturday, May 2nd, 2026 – Just over two weeks away! To celebrate, the Weiz Guys Homebrew Club of Loveland, Colorado, is hosting the Big Brew Day Competition. Bring your club together, celebrate Big Brew Day, create one or all three of the official recipes for Big Brew, and compete in a club versus club competition. Which AHA registered homebrew club in the USA can brew the best version of the official recipe?

Winners of the Competition (First, Second, and Third-place clubs)

- Will have their homebrew club featured in *Zymurgy* Magazine
- Will have all entry fees donated to their designated charitable organization.
 - First-place winner: 50% of all entry fees.
 - Second and third-place winners: 25% each of all entry fees.

Schedule of Events

- 06/15/2026: Entry Window Opens
- 08/24/2026: Competition Entry Window closes / All entries must be received.
- 08/29/2026: Big Brew Day Competition

Official Rules

- You must enter the competition as an AHA registered homebrew club.
 - **Each club is allowed one (1) entry for each official recipe, or a total of three (3) entries.**
 - Entry fee is \$25 per entry. All entry fees go to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner's designated charities.
 - An entry consists of three (3) 10 ounce or larger bottles/cans.
 - **All entries must be one of the [official recipes](#) for Big Brew Day 2026.**
 - **All entries in the competition must be brewed at a gathering of your homebrew club.**
 - **A gathering is defined as at least two (2) individuals.**
 - Homebrew clubs are encouraged to brew several batches of the official Big Brew Day 2026 recipes and to hold a club-only competition to select the club's competition entry(s).
 - All homebrew clubs must designate a registered charitable organization.
- A photograph of your club brewing on Big Brew Day is required. If you win, this photograph will be used in *Zymurgy* Magazine. Up to four (4) photographs may be submitted.
